



Brighton Ski Resort is located on top of Big Cottonwood Canyon just 35 minutes southeast of downtown Salt Lake City, Utah.

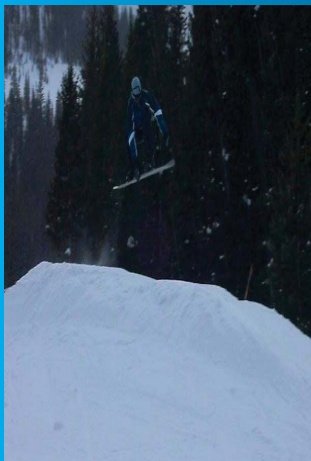

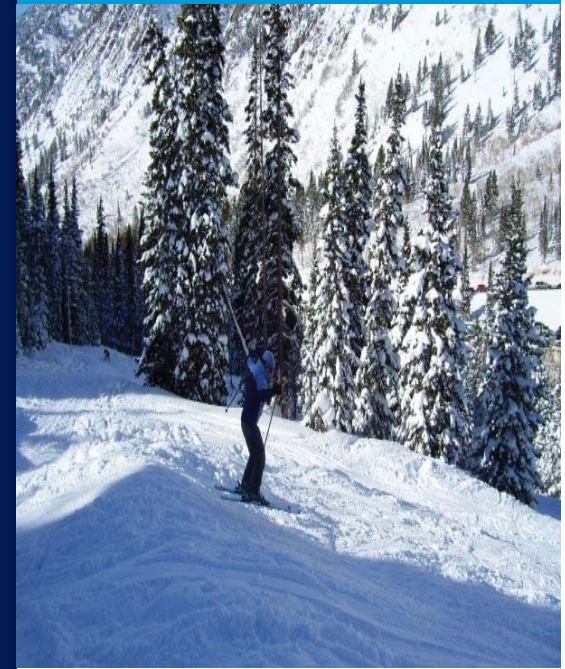

What to Expect

The forecast for Dec. 24, is 18 degrees and sunny with a wind-chill of 15 degrees.



There is a 50 percent chance of snow between 10 a.m. and 12 p.m. on Dec. 24, with a 95 percent chance of 3 inches of newly fallen snow on the night of Dec. 23.



The slopes should have a fresh coat of powder, and there is a forecasted visibility of 90 percent.

What to Bring

Your lift tickets, if you purchased them ahead of time

Your gear or money to rent it

Gloves, Hats, Goggles, Scarves, Hand Warmers, Wool Socks, Ski Jacket, Multiple Warm Layers, Pants and Change of Clothes

Make sure you bring a vehicle with four wheel drive or chains on the tires because it could get icy driving on the mountain.

Remember to bring an ice scraper, tissues, sunscreen and lip balm!

Don't forget to bring money for food and donations!!!

The Plan

Arrive early because it will be crowded.

Pick up a free map of Brighton's ski resort.

Designate a meeting place in case you become separated from someone you are skiing with.

While waiting in line or when riding the chair lift, plan out which runs you want to ski and the route you will take to get there.

Take into account what time each chairlift closes so you can ski every side of Brighton's lovely mountains.
